

#EndSARS protests: Group decries unlawful shooting, killings in Mushin

A group under the auspices of Mushin To The World Foundation has condemned unlawful shooting and destruction of lives and properties in Mushin community during the ENDSARS protest in many parts of Lagos State three days ago.

Besides, the group, in a statement signed on Saturday by its co-founder/Board Secretary, Mr Babatunde Enitan, said the

most annoying part was the killing of innocent citizens and destruction of properties that took place in the locality were not mentioned by any of the authorities.

"We are pained that our people in Mushin whose lives have been lost and whose properties have been destroyed have not been dignified with a mention by any of the authorities as if they do not matter. Mushin lives do matter," the group stated.

It added that as of the time of issuing the statement (Saturday), verifiable facts on the ground in Mushin and its environs showed that 14 people died, while other victims are still in different hospitals receiving treatments.

"The following represent the verifiable facts on the ground in the Mushin environs: Lagos University Teaching Hospital - 23 casualties (five confirmed dead), one seriously injured, four people

at the theatre while others are being managed at the Accident and Emergency section.

"Aishat Hospital - One casualty (bullet). The bullet penetrated his lungs and he is being managed because they do not want to lose him;

"Mushin General Hospital, Oluyide - 43 casualties. Eight deaths, five taken by their families, three are battling for their lives others seriously injured," the group said.
