Troops kill 8 terrorists, rescue victims in North East

THE Defence Headquarter says troops of Operation Din Ball have eliminated eigh Boko Haram and Islamic State West Africa Province (ISWAP terrorists in recent encounter in the North East.

According to the New Agency of Nigeria (NAN), the Agency of Nigeria (NAN), the Acting Director, Defence Me dia Operations, Brigadier-General Bernard Onyeuko, in a statement on Tuesday, said Operation fire Ball was a subsidiary operation under Operation Lafiya Dole.

Onyeuko added that the troops also rescued a woman and three children just as the recovered large cache of arm during the encounter acros the theatre of operation,

He disclosed that the troop had between November 7 and 8 thwarted attempts by Bok Haram/ISW/AP terrorists to in filtrate Buni Gari town in Yobe State and eliminated five o them.

According to him, troops re covered one fabricated (VBL Armoured Personnel Carrier one guntruck, one NSVT An ti-Aircraft Gun, one OJC An ti-Aircraft Gun, one Rocke Propelled Grenade Tube, one PKT gun, one GPMG, one OJC Extra Barrel, six AK-47 rifles, 31: rounds of 7.62mm NATO am munition from the encounter.

Onyeuko also disclosed that that troops of 151 Task Force Battalion deployed in Miyant in Bama Local Governmen Area of Borno State, destroyed terrorists' hideout and rescued one woman and three childres on Novmber 8.

He added that two bicycle and other items were recov ered from the fleeing insur gents,
