

## Tension as herdsmen kill farmer in Osun

Tension is brewing in Ijabe in Odo-Otin Local Government Area of Osun-State after some herdsmen allegedly killed a middle-aged man, simply identified as Ridwan, on his farm on Tuesday.

The deceased, popularly known as "Radoo," was said

to have been killed by the herdsmen who invaded his farm with several cows at noon.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that the killing had been preceded by a misunderstanding between the deceased and one of the herdsmen last year.

The main suspect was

alleged to have mobilised several other herdsmen to graze on the deceased's farm located at Boole village, on Iba Road.

The development said to have infuriated the villagers who went to the herdsmens' settlement, arrested the suspect and handed him over to the police.

Speaking on the incident, a police officer who preferred anonymity said the state police command had been informed of the incident.

However, when contacted, the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Yemisi Opalola, said she would get across to newsmen later.
