Suspected herders allegedly hack lady to death in Ogun

A lady identified as Elizabeth Pascal was allegedly hacked to death by suspected herders in Imeko Afon area of Ogun State on Monday.

The victim, it was learnt, was ambushed and killed by the suspected herders while returning from a stream where she had gone to fetch water at CAC Olorunda, Moriwi community in the area on Monday evening.

The Eselu of Iselu, Oba Akintunde Akinyemi, confirmed the development to newsmen.

The traditional ruler said the lady was allegedly killed by the suspected herdsmen terrorising communities in Yewa North Local Government Area of the state.

Oba Akinyemi said that the incident happened at about 3:00 p.m. on Monday.

"Yes, it is true. The lady was killed today (Monday) by suspected herdsmen around Imeko Afon. She went to the stream and on her way back, she met them and they killed her. It happened around 3:00 p.m. according to the report," the traditional ruler stated.
