

Wamakko's aide abducted, killed by gunmen in Sokoto

THE personal aide of Senator Aliyu Magatakarda Wamakko, Alhaji Abba Abbey Gidan Haki, who was abducted by some unknown gunmen on Thursday night, has been found dead and his remains have been buried on Friday night in Sokoto

This was contained in a

statement signed by the Special Assistant on Media and Publicity to the Senator, Bashir Rabe Mani, and made available to newsmen in Sokoto on Saturday.

The statement further said his funeral prayer was led by the Chief Imam of Sheikh Uthman Bin Fodiyo Juma'at Mosque, Sokoto, Sheikh Abubakar Shehu Na Liman.

The funeral prayer was attended by Senator Wamakko; the Minister of Police Affairs, Alhaji Muhammadu Maigari Dingyadi; the state acting Chairman of APC, Alhaji Isa Sadiq Achida; traditional rulers, Islamic clerics, members of the National and state assemblies, serving and retired civil servants, as well as thousands

of sympathisers, among others.

The deceased who was aged about fifty years, was abducted and killed on Thursday night, while his dead body was found on the road to Durbawa town, Kware Local Government Area of the State. He is survived by a wife and five children.
