

Bandits kill five,  
one decomposing  
corpse recovered  
in Kaduna

Gunmen kill two  
policemen, son of  
Delta chief priest

1 SECURITY agencies have reported that armed bandits attacked Katarma village in Chikun Local Government Area of Kaduna State.

According to a statement issued by the state Commissioner for Internal Security and Home Affairs, Samuel Aruwan, on Sunday, five persons were killed in the attack.

The commissioner listed those killed as Samson Dandadi, Luka Gajere, Amos Ali, Titus Baba and Damali Musa, just as he added that one person was injured and is already receiving treatment in a neighbouring state.

2 "Also, troops of Operation Safe Haven, while on patrol, discovered the decomposing corpse of one Paul Simon, a resident of Yagbak village in Zangon Kataf LGA. The deceased was reported missing on March 24, and the corpse has since been buried.

3 In a related development, gunmen on Saturday killed two policemen and a son of the traditional chief priest of Orhuwhorun kingdom in Udu Local Government Area of Delta State.

The incident, which occurred at Effurun in Uvwie Local Government Area, has thrown the kingdom into mourning, with a further report that one of the victims is battling for his life in hospital.

The two policemen were said to be guards attached to the two sons of the chief priest.

The acting Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), DSP Bright Edefe, confirmed the killing of the two mobile policemen.

He further confirmed that one of the two boys died, while the other is still in the hospital recuperating.
