LG boss kidnapped as two die in Rivers' cult clashes

GUNMEN on Wednesday kidnapped the chairman of Okrika Local Government Area of Rivers State, Pholemon Kingoli, just as two persons were reportedly killed following a shootout between two rival cult groups in the state also on Wednesday.

The local government

chairman was kidnapped on Odili Road, while the cult clashes occurred around Old Port Harcourt Township.

Details about the kidnap of the local government chairman was still sketchy as of the time of filing this report, but it was gathered that the abductors are vet to make any contact with the victim's family.
