Jewelries, other valuable items carted away as armed robbers kill night guard in Osun

A middle aged night guard identified as Matthew Olalekan was on Thursday night killed by armed robbers at Technical College area in Osogbo, Osun state capital. The deceased said to be

guarding a shop located directly opposite Technical College area, where kids wares were being sold, met his sudden death when the robbers invaded the shop, carting away properties worth millions of naira and shot him dead.

The incident, according to investigations, reportedly caused panic around the vicinity as residents and shop owners where the incident happened, wept profusely and lamented the development.

Some of the items reportedly carted away by

the night marauders were expensive jewelries, babies mattresses, phone chargers and yet to be identified other valuable goods.

When contacted, the state police command public relations officer, Mrs. Yemisi Opalola confirmed the

incident and hinted that the state Criminal Investigation Department of the command had commenced investigation to fish out the perpetrators of the act.

The police spokesperson who gave the age of the deceased as 40 years, said his

remains had been deposited at the morgue of Osun State University Teaching Hospital Complex, Osogbo.

She, however, assured that the perpetrators of the dastardly act would be brought to book in no distant time.
