

Two die as fire razes Taraba community

TWO persons were killed and about 100 houses destroyed on Tuesday evening when Bandawa community in Karim Lamido Local Government Area of Taraba State was razed by fire.

The state Commissioner for Humanitarian Affairs and Natural Disasters, Honourable Binga Tanninga, who confirmed the incident to *Nigerian Tribune*, expressed sadness over the development.

The commissioner said government's delegation had already been sent to the community to ascertain the level of destruction for immediate action in order to ease the suffering of the people.

Tanninga said his ministry was already compiling reports of natural disasters that occurred in the state within the year to submit to the Federal Government for assistance through the National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA).
