## Five feared killed as armed robbers invade bank in Osun

NO fewer than five persons were reportedly killed on Wednesday in Ikire, in Irewole Local Government Area of Osun State when armed robbers invaded a new generation bank in the town.

It was gathered that the armed robbers, who had earlier operated at Apomu town at about 3:00 p.m., moved to Ikire, where they killed three persons at a commercial bank's Automated Teller Machine (ATM).

It was further learnt that two other persons were killed when in the town when the robbers shot indiscriminately to scare residents of the area.

The Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) in the state, Mrs Yemisi Opalola, confirmed the incident, adding that the Commissioner of Police, Olawale Olokode, had visited the scene of the incident.

She, however, could not ascertain the number of casualties recorded in the incident.
