

Again, suspected herders kill 11 in Benue

A state by state breakdown of recent incidents in Benue and Nasarawa states.

In Nasarawa on Wednesday, May 23, 2018, 11 others in Makurdi town were killed in Nasarawa state early hours of yesterday. Details

from Commissioner of Police, Anthony Dyergh, said youths were still searching for missing persons.

Dyergh said: "The Fulani had attacked for some villages were being burnt to the ground this morning [Tuesday], knowing full well that many of the villages would be set for the farm after the downpour. They hid in the bush and allowed farmers to go and they then came after them and hacked them."

"So I am talking to you now, we have been able to recover the corpses and the youth are searching for others who are still missing."

The village is behind the Nasarawa barracks, North Bank in Nasarawa."

In the second attack at Anka community in Makurdi town wed in Nasarawa state others were killed on Wednesday after

Beng said the invasion occurred between 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday in Anyon, which borders Tafawa Balewa State.

"Six people were confirmed dead, while the whereabouts of some remains unknown," Beng said.

However, spokesperson for the state police command, DSP Catherine Anene, said she was yet to get details about the two incidents.
