

Five feared killed, 10 others abducted in Niger village

Five persons were on Monday feared killed, while 10 others were said to have been abducted when gunmen suspected to be bandits attacked Madaka village in Rafi Local Government Area of Niger State.

Nigerian Tribune learnt that the bandits initially killed two persons in the village and abducted 10 people, after which they released about seven persons among the abductees.

Three persons who were later on the trial of the bandits were then reported killed.

It was gathered that two persons who injured during the attack are now receiving treatment at both the Minna General Hospital and Bida Medical Centre in Bida Local Government Area of the state.

Efforts to speak to the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) in the state, DSP Wasiu Abiodun, failed as calls made to his phone did not connect.
