

Gunmen kill unidentified man in Ibadan

The killing wasn't reported to police —PPRO

BARELY 48 hours after a popular radio presenter, Titus Badejo, was killed by gunmen at Oluyole area of Ibadan, the Oyo State capital, an unidentified middle-aged man was, on Monday, shot dead by suspected armed robbers along the University of Ibadan-Ojoo expressway.

A credible source informed Nigerian Tribune that the incident occurred at about 2:45 p.m. at Water Bus Stop, along the University of Ibadan-Ojoo Road.

The unidentified man, who was said to have just withdrawn a huge sum of money from a new gener-

ation bank located around the area, was shot in his private part.

However, it could not be ascertained if the suspected armed robbers, who operated on a motorcycle, made away with the money.

The source added that the man was rushed to a private hospital where he was confirmed dead.

When contacted, the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) in the state, Adewale Osifeso, said the matter was not reported to the police, saying the Divisional

Police Officer (DPO) of Ojoo said nobody reported the case at the station.

Osifeso said further that: "I have also linked up with the DPOs of other neighbouring commands. The relatives of the slain man just took his corpse to a mortuary without informing the police. I have sent messages out and I am yet to get anything. The problem is that some people will not report to the police when incidents like this happen. How can the police know or take action?"
