

# Robbers shoot dead wife of ex-commissioner in Oyo

SUSPECTED armed robbers in the early hours of Friday in Ibadan, Oyo State shot dead the wife of a former chairman of Ogbomosho South Local Government and former commissioner under the administration of former Governor Abiola Ajimobi, Mr Peter Odetomi, Saturday Tribune reliably gathered.

Credible sources informed our correspondent that the woman, Mrs Olayemi Odetomi was shot dead by the armed robbers at their family house, located around Ashi, Bodija, Ibadan.

The robbers were said to have stormed the victim's residence on motorcycles, shooting sporadically before gaining

access into the premises.

As of the time of filing this report, it could not be ascertained valuables or properties taken away by the armed robbers.

Though details of the killing was still sketchy, the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) of Oyo State Police command, Mr Adewale Osifeso said it was a robbery incident.

In a statement forwarded to our correspondent, Osifeso stated that "the deceased, Olayemi Odetomi, aged 66 years, died on the spot after being shot during a robbery incident which occurred during the early hours of Friday 25th June, 2021 in her home. Updates on investigations would be provided in due course."
