

Many feared dead as Boko Haram attacks Hong community again

Suspected Fulani gunmen kill village head, 2 others in Taraba

MANY people were killed as Boko Haram attacked Danga Village, Hong Local Government Area in Adamawa State in the early hours of Wednesday.

An eyewitness, Hella Michael said one of the community's civilian warriors who attempted to repel the insurgents was among those killed during the attack.

"As I speak with you now, half of the community has run away to neighbouring villages for fear of being attacked."

Other eyewitnesses also said that the people in Garaha, are also not safe as about 18 persons were discovered dead in the bush by Nigerian Military.

All efforts to reach out to 23 Armoured Brigade public relations officer, Major Mohammed Haruna Sani to confirm the story proved abortive.

Even text message and calls put across to the Brigade Commander, Brigadier General Aminu Garba was not returned as he pressed user busy.

In the same development, suspected Fulani gunmen on Tuesday night killed the Mai-Angwan Tiv, in Kundli district, Zaki Terzungwe Anjua and two others in a night attack in Bali Local Government Area of Taraba State.

The deceased who had just returned from IDPs camp in Bali on the directive of Governor Darius Ishaku that all displaced persons in the area should be allowed unhindered access to their homes and farm lands was killed at about 10:20 p.m.

It was gathered that the attackers had taken the man's farmland and decided to kill him to avert trouble, should

the man report them to the governor.

An eyewitness, who is the son of the Mai-Angwan Tiv, who escaped the attack told Nigerian Tribune on phone that the attackers invaded their compound and shot his

father before cutting him and two others with cutlasses.

The attack came barely 48 hours after the Public Relations Officer of Miyetti Allah, Murtala Usman, informed

Bali Local Government Area had been resolved.

Taraba State Public Relations Officer, DSP David Misal could not pick calls or reply to text message sent to his phone as at the time of filing in this report.
