

Flood kills two okada riders in Ondo

A torrential rainfall that lasted several hours wreaked havoc in Ondo town, headquarters of Ondo West Local Government Area of Ondo State, claiming the lives of two commercial motorcyclists known as okada, one of who is the chairman of ACOMORAN riders in the

area, known as Aderemi.

Aderemi and two other victims, including a passenger, were washed away after the downpour on Monday evening, but the passenger was rescued and is currently receiving treatment at the hospital.

According to an eyewitness, the remains of the two okada riders were recovered in Oka area of the town, near the Okeodunwo Bridge.
