Community mourns as seven members of same family found dead in Osun

ABOUT seven members of the same family were found dead on Tuesday morning in their house at Apomu in Isokan Local Government Area of Osun State.

The cause of their death, which is still a mystery as of the time of filing this report, has thrown residents of the area into mourning.

The incident, which occurred at Oke-Suna area of the town, according to eyewitness account, is now the talk of town.

A source who preferred anonymity told *Nigerian*

Tribune that the bodies of the deceased had been deposited at a mortuary in the town.

The source said: "We cannot explain what led to this, but people are saying that they sprayed some chemicals, probably insecticide or so before they went to bed."

Commenting on the incident, the Osun State police command spokesperson, Mrs Yemisi Opalola, said the police are currently investigating the cause of the tragedy.

She said: "We have seen the victims and the police are working to uncover the mystery behind the deaths."
