

Oke-Ogun Poly debunks rumour of student's death by security personnel

THE management of Oke-Ogun Polytechnic, Saki, Oyo State has debunked the rumour that a security personnel hit a student with charms which led to the student's death.

The rumour caused crisis within the school premises on Monday. Some enraged students destroyed the security post and some facilities in the institution.

According to a statement signed by the institution Public Relations Officer, Mr Kayode Olabode, the student was no more in the school and was arrested with hard

drugs by the security man.

"The said student was badly dressed while the security officer on duty discovered that he had taken hard drugs and he was subsequently arrested.

"However, on the way to the security office, his cohorts raised a false alarm, claiming that the student collapsed and died, leading to the crisis."

The management while calling on members of Staff to continue with their activities, assured that adequate security measures had been put in place.
