

Bouncer stabs boy to death at wedding ceremony in Delta

A bouncer, Francis (surname withheld), has been arrested for allegedly stabbing to death a teenage boy at a wedding reception in Delta State.

The incident occurred on Saturday, September 25, at a wedding reception held at a hotel in Mofor, Udu Local Government Area, near Warri.

Sources said tragedy occurred midway at the reception when the boy attempted to pick up some naira notes being 'sprayed' on the dancing couple as the bouncer grabbed and stabbed him.

The deceased, who lived on Kolokolo Street in Udu, it was gathered, had gone to the wedding party with his mother, who had reportedly lost an older son two months earlier.

The deceased and his mother were reportedly neighbours of the groom, hence their presence at the wedding ceremony.

The Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) in the state, Bright Edafe, who confirmed the development, said the suspect had been apprehended.

Edafe said: "It happened at a hotel. The suspect is in our custody."
