

Seven killed in Kwara auto crash

S EVEN persons died on Tuesday morning in a lone accident at Ayekale village, on the Ibadan-Ilorin expressway.

The auto crash, which oc-

curred due to speeding, involved a commercial vehicle called Toyota Bumper, with registration number ZAR 600 XY.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that the crash, which involved 19 males, had 12 of them sustaining varying degrees of in-

jury, while seven persons died on the spot.

The sector commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) in the state, Jonathan Owoade, who confirmed the incident, said there was no first aid treatment given to the victims

when the accident occurred at about 4:00 a.m.

Owoade, who said the police from Bode Saadu division took the injured victims to a nearby hospitals for medical treatment, added that men of the FRSC took the deceased to the University

of Ilorin Teaching Hospital (UITH) mortuary.

The FRSC boss also added that personal items recovered from the victims had been deposited at the Nigeria Police Division, Bode Saadu, in Moro Local Government Area of the state.
