Police arrest man, 27, who killed lover in Bauchi

BAUCHI State Police Command has arrested one 27-year-old Enoch Yohanna of Gwallameji Doka, a suburb of Bauchi metropolis for allegedly killing his lover, Ruth Amos out of jealousy.

According to the Police Public Relations Officer, SP Ahmed Wakili, on October 7, a Joint patrol team in collaboration with the Peace and Security Committee while on visibility patrol, sighted a young lady laying in a pool of blood with wounds on her head and blood gushing out from her mouth at Sabon Kaura area of the state.

The PPRO in a press release stated that the team evacuated the victim to Abubakar Tafawa Balewa University Teaching Hospital, (ATBUTH) Bauchi, where a medical doctor confirmed her dead.

The PPRO further stated that during the course of investigation, one 56-yearold Hajara Amos of Bayara village, who was identified as the deceased's mother, also identified the 28-yearold Ruth Amos of the same address.

According to the police spokesman, the suspect, on interrogation, confessed to have committed the crime, while further investigation revealed that Enoch Yohanna and the deceased (Ruth Amos) were in a romantic relationship and had two children.

It was further revealed that on the date of the incident, Enoch sighted the deceased coming out of a compound and out of jealousy, he challenged her, which led to an argument between them and in the process he pushed her and she hit her head on the ground.

The PPRO said the deceased was wounded and bled profusely before giving up the ghost, adding that the suspect would be profiled and charged to court as

soon as possible.
