Four feared killed as Delta communities clash over land

FOUR persons have been feared killed during a gun duel between Okwagbe several people inujured. and Owahwa communities in Ughelli South Local Government Area of Delta State over an age-long land dispute.

Althought details of the incident are sketchy, it was gathered late Thursday that the two neighbouring communities engaged themselves in a gun duet, leaving

It was gathered that while three persons were feared dead on the side of Okwagbe, one death was recorded against Owahwa.

A source confirmed the development in a text

message to the Nigerian Tribune: "Yes, three persons were killed at Okwagbe and one killed at Okwakwa community over an age-long land dispute. Police already deployed in the area."

Okwagbe is a village in Ughelli South Local Government Area located on the Forcados river, and

shares boundaries Oginibo, Okuemor, Otegbo, Owahwa, Egbo-Ide Okreka (Ofonibaya) communities, among others

The Police Public Retations Officer (PPRO) in the state. Bright Edafe, confirmed the development. but did not give details of casualties.
