Two die in early Monday crash in Kwara

TWO persons reportedly lost their lives in a lone accident early Monday morning on Ilorin-Bode Saadu expressway in Kwara State.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that the accident, involving a white commercial Toyota Hiace bus, was caused by tyre burst and loss of control of the vehicle.

The accident occurred at Olokonla community in Moro Local Government Area at about 4:00 a.m.

It was also gathered that about six persons were involved in the accident, as three persons reportedly sustained varying degrees of injuries.

The First Information Report (FIR) issued by the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) said the driver, identified as Tekno, had no driver's licence.

The incident was confirmed by the sector commander of the FRSC in the state, Jonathan Owoade.

The FRSC boss, who said that those injured had been taken to a nearby private hospital, Adua Hospital, added that one of them was later referred to the University of Ilorin Teaching Hospital (UITH).

He also said that the corpses of the deceased had been deposited at the UITH mortuary.

Owoade said items recovered at the scene of the accident were in the custody of the police who he said arrived scene of the crash first.
