Suspected 'Yahoo Boy' kills two, injures four in Ondo accident

TWO persons were on Sunday evening killed, while four others were injured in an auto accident which occurred in Ondo town, headquarters of Ondo West Local Government Area of Ondo State.

The accident, which involved a Toyota Camry and a tricycle around NEPA, on Ademulegun road, left two of

the occupants of the tricycle dead on the spot.

It was gathered that the driver of the Toyota Camry, suspected to be a 'Yahoo Boy,' who was driving on top speed, rammed into the tricycle, killing the driver and a passenger and injuring others.

The driver of the vehicle escaped immediately from the scene, while residents of the

community set the vehicle ablaze.

An eyewitness explained that the driver, who was on top speed during the downpour, lost control of the vehicle and rammed into the tricycle.

Personnel of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) who visited the scene rushed the injured to the hospital and deposited the corpses at the morgue.

The Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO) in the state, Funmilayo Odunlami, confirmed that two persons died, while four others were injured.

Odunlami said the identity of the suspect was yet to be known, just as she added that, "I cannot confirm if the driver of the vehicle is a Yahoo Boy or not."
