## Five die in Lagos-Ibadan expressway tanker explosion

Another three killed in bus accident

IT was a black Wednesday as eight persons lost their lives in a tanker explosion and bus accident on the Lagos-Ibadan expressway. :

Nigerian Tribune learnt that a tanker laden with Premium Spirit Motor (PMS) spilt its content following a head-on collision with a truck, before it exploded around Kwakyama area in Ogere axis.

Five persons lost their lives in the explosion, while another three persons died when a commercial bus caught fire around Sand Crete in Ogunmakin axis on the same expressway at about 2:52 p.m.
