Church sweeper hacked to death in Ondo

A middle-aged woman identified as Mrs Omode was on Sunday morning hacked to death by some unidentified persons in Iwaro Oka in Akoko South-West Local Government Area of Ondo State

ernment Area of Ondo State.

The woman, who was going to church to sweep it, was said to have been cut in the neck by her assailants.

A source said: "Mrs Omode usually went to the church every Sunday morning to sweep, and that was where she was going when the assailants hacked her to death."

The source explained that the incident occurred between 5:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., adding that the killers left her in a pool of

her blood very close to the church at Walusi area of the community.

He said her remains were discovered by some residents who alerted the police, who later came to evacuate the body to the morgue.

Confirming the incident, the Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Funmilayo Odunlami, said the incident was a case of murder.

Odunlami explained that the woman was hacked to death with machete, adding that the assailants cut her in the neck.

The police spokesperson, however, said detectives from the state had commenced investigation into the case, just as she added that those behind the killing would be apprehended.
