

# Four killed, eight injured in Ogun auto crash

FOUR people lost their lives on Sunday, while eight others sustained injuries in an accident that occurred at Lufwape area on the Lagos-Ibadan expressway.

The accident involved a passenger bus and a truck.

The sector commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) in Ogun State, Ahmed Umar, said the accident occurred at about 3.40 p.m.

Umar said the accident was as a result of excesses on the part of the truck driver who sped dangerously.

He stated that 20 people were involved in the accident, comprising 12 males and eight females, saying that eight males and six females sustained injuries, while two males and two females died in the accident.

“The truck driver drove dangerously, which made the Mazda bus to lose control and crashed on the highway. Unfortunately, the truck driver escaped,” he said.

Umar said the injured victims were taken to Idera Hospital in Sagamu for treatment, while the bodies of the deceased were deposited at the same hospital's mortuary.
