Police confirm arrest of suspected killers of three in Ibadan

OYO State police command has confirmed the arrest of suspected killers of three persons at Oremeji Agugu area in Ibadan metropolis at the weekend.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Adewale Osifeso, in a statement made available to the **Nigerian Tribune** on Sunday, disclosed that the incident was a cult-related violence.

He said some hoodlums had been arrested in relation to the violence, but declined comment on their numbers and identities.

Osifeso stated that investigation was still ongoing on the matter, adding that disclosing their identities at this point in time would jeopardise investigation.

The statement read in part, "Cult related violence broke out at the early hours of Friday, February 11, between some hood-lums around Oremeji Area. Ibadan.

"Upon the strength of a distress call received by operatives of the Oyo State police command, deployments of operational and tactical assets were swiftly executed."
