Four dead, seven injured in Bauchi auto crash

BAUCHI Sector command of the Federal Roads Safety Corps (FRSC), on Sunday confirmed that a road accident claimed four lives while seven others were injured and receiving treatment at the Trauma Centre of the Specialists Hospital, Bauchi.

The FRSC hinted that the accident occurred at about 1500 hours

on along Bauchi - Kano road, explaining that it involved two commercial vehicles, an Opel Vectra with registration number, AA 268 SHR and Sharon mini bus which registration number could not be ascertained immediately coming from opposite direction before a head-on collision at Sabongari village.

It was further disclosed

that three people died on the spot of the accident, while another died at the hospital due to the degree of the injury from the accident.

Evacuation of the victims was done by a Special marshal, Adamu Abubakar alongside other regular Corps Marshal rescued team, who responded to the distress call immediately the accident occurred.

At the hospital, three people were confirmed to be stable, including a male child who had been treated and discharged.

The possible cause of the accident, according to the FRSC was over-speeding and dangerous driving, leading to the bursting of front tyre of Vectra car, which forced it to swerve to the other lane and collide with the oncoming Sharon mini bus.
