Gunmen kill vigilante in Delta

THE land dispute between the Ogwashi Uku community Aniocha South Council area and its neighbour, Ibusa in Aniocha North of Delta took a dramatic turn on Monday as a member of Aboh-Ogwashi vigilante group was shot dead.

Gunmen had stormed the Ogwa meeting hall of the Okwabani of Aboh -Ogwashi in three vehicles Monday morning, shooting sporadically to cause tension in the sleepy satellite town.

The victim, identified as Chukwuwike Alawo. was allegedly shot at close, range with several others including the leader of the to have abandoned their vigilante group and the task force on land recovery, Mr Nnamdi Nwaebonnor, who were seriously injured

Nigerian Tribune reports that some people were buldozinng a parcel of land behind Admiralty University of Nigeria along Asaba-Ibusa-Ogwashi Uku road when members of the Aboh vigilante group accosted them.

The workers were said equipment and a pump action gun was recovered by the vigilante members.

Reacting to the attack, the



Okwaubani of Aboh- Ogwashi, Chief Jude Obidi, said he was not too sure whether the attackers were from Ibusa or are elements from his predecessors in office.

When contacted, the state police public relations officer, DSP Bright Edafe, confirmed the attack on the Ogwa and killing of the vigilante member, saving investigation into the matter had commenced.
