FCT police nab four for alleged murder

THE Federal Capital Territory (FCT) Police command has arrested four people in connection with the alleged murder of one Sani Abdullahi, in Giri village in Abuja.

In a statement made available to pressmen in Abuja through the FCT Police Relations Officer Public (PPRO), DSP Josephine Adeh, the FCT Police Commissioner, Babaji Sunday, stated that "consequently, command's intelligence and investigative assests attatched to the division were detailed for action, leading to the arrest of the following suspects; Timothy Emmanuel, Joshua Sunday, Usman Mohammed Danlami Steven, all male of 24, 21, 20, and 24 years old respectively.

"All effort to conduct an autopsy on the deceased proved abortive as the

relatives vehemently insisted on retrieving and burying him according to Islamic rites.

"Following the above, the incidence degenerated into a tense situation in the area which was immediately greeted with heavy deployment Police personnel to the village. Meanwhile, resulting from a concerted effort of the Police, sister security agencies, and stakeholders in the community, normalcy has been restored, while monitoring and investigation continues in the area.

"On the 14th of March, 2022, at about 0030hrs, the Gwagwalada Divisional Police headquarters received information from a well meaning resident of Giri village about the attack on Sani Abdullahi, a male of Hausa extraction, who was allegedly hacked severely on his farm on the 13th of March, 2022.
