2 killed as toilet walls collapse in Niger community



TWO teenagers were on Friday killed when the walls of a toilet collapsed on them in Paiko town, headquarters of Paikoro Local Government Council of Niger State.

Sunday Tribune investigation gathered that one of those killed was a female streets hawker, selling sachet water, while the boy who also lost his life to the collapsed toilet was described as a scavenger.

It was further gathered that the toilet had been under construction at the dump site of the Central Primary School Paiko for a while before it fell on the iduo.

Sympathisers were said to have rushed to the scene to rescue the victims but on getting there it was discovered that one of the victims was badly injured, thereby leading to his intestine

thrown out of the stomach.

Further checks however revealed that three other teenagers were allegedly affected by the unfortunate incident at the scene of the collapsed toilet wall and were quickly rushed to the Paiko General hospital for Medical treatment where it was said that they were confirmed dead by Medical personnel on duty.

in Minna by Telephone, the Director General of the Niger State Emergency Management Agency (NSEMA) Alhaji Ahmed Ibrahim Inga confirmed the incident, adding that the incident happened but that the details were yet to be ascertained as of the time of filing this report on Saturday in Minna.
