

3 killed, 16 injured in Bauchi auto accident

BAUCHI State Command of the Federal Roads Safety Corps (FRSC) has confirmed that a lone ghastly motor accident that occurred Friday evening in Kurosha village, Ganjuwa Local Government Area of Bauchi State has claimed three lives while 16 others were injured.

The confirmation was contained in a report from the Ganjuwa Station office of the FRSC stating that the accident occurred at about 18:13hrs of Friday and was reported at 18:20hrs while operatives arrived at scene for rescue operation at 18:28hrs barely 8 minutes after the report was received.

The RTC signed by DRC KM Chadi, STO of Ganjuwa and endorsed by the NPF, Kafin Madaki Division contained that the accident involving a Toyota Hiace commercial bus belonging to the fleet of Jigawa Sunrise occurred at Kurosha village, 1km away from Gadar Maiwa in Ningi Local Government Area of Bauchi State along the ever busy Bauchi - Kano highway.

According to the FRSC, the cause of the accident was speed limit violation (SPV) and loss of control (LOC) by the driver whose name could not be immediately ascertained.

A total of 20 passengers; 18 male adults, one female adult and one female child were involved in the accident out of which 16 comprising 15 male adults and one female adult were injured at various degrees.

All the accident victims including the dead were evacuated to Ningi General Hospital for treatment and confirmation of death after which the corpses were deposited at the mortuary.
