UNMEN pected to be Fulani militia have killed 12 people and injured 28 others at Chando Zerreci community in Bassa Local Government Area of Plateau State

The Irigwe land in the council area has been under attack by gunmen for a while

"As of now, searching for victims is still ongoing, and that means the report can be updated in case of any new information."

Speaking with the Nigerian Tribune, the National President of IDA, Prince Robert others sustained gunshot in- Ashi, who condemned persistent attacks on the Irgwes, said the government and security agencies have the perpetrators.

Prince Ashi added that the attacks were deliberate to annihilate the Irigwe and to take over their land.

When contacted, the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), ASP Ubah Gabriel Ogaba, confirmed the attack.

He, however, added that operatives of the command had been deployed in the affected community.
