

Police arrest one
as kidnappers
kill two, abduct
three within three
days in Lagos
community

ONE person has been arrested in connection with the killing of two persons and abduction of three others by a yet-to-be identified gang of kidnappers in the Ayobo area of Lagos.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that preliminary investigations have it that the abductors have contacts in the community.

The police in the state have, however, deployed the Special Tactical Squad to the area, while residents have engaged the services of men of the Oodua Peoples Congress (OPC) and local hunters to rescue the abducted residents.

The image maker in charge of the state police command, Benjamin Hundeyin, confirmed the killing and the abduction to the Nigerian Tribune, just as he added that efforts had begun to rescue the abducted residents.

Two persons, identified as Nurudeen Olanrewaju and Idris Olowolayemo, were killed last Friday while challenging the gunmen who had gone to Ayobo Housing Scheme Extension, Oshin, to abduct two married women.

It was gathered that the gunmen, who reportedly came from Ogun State, returned on Sunday to abduct another resident of the community and escaped through the waterway in the area.
