## One feared killed, others injured in Lagos-Ibadan expressway accident

NE person has been feared killed while others were injured in a road accident involving a truck and an 18-seater bus on the Lagos-Ibadan expressway.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that the Ibadan-bound bus was crushed by an articulated truck.

One of the passengers, according to an eyewitness, died on the spot, while the others were taken to a nearby hospital for medical attention.

Also speaking on the devel-

opment, a driver who identified himself as Taiwo Oyewale, attributed the accident to recklessness on the part of the truck driver.

Oyewale said he did not know the actual number of people who died, but saw corpses at the scene before officials of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) moved the victims to the hospital.

He said: "I was not there when the accident occurred, but I arrived there few minutes later. It was obvious that the truck driver drove against traffic.
