2 23-year-old arrested for allegedly raping, killing OAU graduate

OPERATIVES of the Ogun State police command have arrested a 23-year-old man, James (surname withheld), for allegedly raping and killing 29-year-old Oluwatosin Adefisayo, a graduate of the Obafemi Awolowo University, Ile-Ife.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Abimbola Oyeyemi, said the

Oyeyemi said James, at the time of committing the crime, lived in the same compound with the late Adefisayo.

He was said to have conspired with his friend, said to be at large, to break into the apartment of the deceased at night through the ceiling, raped her and thereafter strangled her.

The PPRO said parents and neighbours of the

deceased woke up to discover her lifeless body in her apartment.

Oyeyemi added that neighbours then invited local vigilantes to the scene, and while there, James was seen coming down from the ceiling where he had been hiding after the act.

Oyeyemi said he was quickly apprehended, while a distress call was made to the police at Ogijo divisional headquarters.

"The Divisional Police Officer, Ogijo, CSP Onatufeh Umoh, quickly led his men to the scene and got the suspect arrested."

During interrogation, Oyeyemi said the suspect, whose partner-in-crime was still at large, confessed to the commission of the crime.

"He also informed the police that they decided to kill the victim after raping her because they discovered that she recognised them."
