Victim of Kaduna train attack, Funtua, dies

ONE of the victims of the recent train attack in Kaduna State, Sergeant Muhammad Haruna Funtua (retd), is dead.

He died as a result of multiple injuries he sustained during the attack.

The deceased, who was shot in the head and chest, was among those rescued by security agencies.

It was gathered that Sergeant Funtua was later conveyed to his town in Funtua for further treatment, where he finally gave up the ghost.

A source who identified

himself as Mallam Idris revealed that the ex-service man died on Tuesday.

Idris said: "He gave a fight to survive but unfortunately, he did not make it.

"We pray Allah will grant his soul Aljannah Firdausi."

During the attack, some of the passengers lost their lives, other sustained injuries while hundreds are still missing.

On Wednesday, the terrorists released the Managing Director of Bank of Agriculture, Alwan Hassan, while threatening to kill others in their captivity if the Federal Government failed to release their leaders.
