Five killed in cult-related attacks in Delta

ABOUT five persons have been killed in Oguashi-Uku community in Aniocha South Local Government Area of Delta State in renewed cult-related attacks.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that the fight for supremacy is between members of the Aye confraternity and Rubagger, who have been gunning for each other for some time now.

A victim who was killed on Wednesday night was identified as Eze, and was attacked on St Patrick Road, at about 7.30 p.m.

Report said the assailants trailed Eze to a nearby spot and immediately he left the place, they opened fire on him at close range.

A source, however, said the bullets shot at Eze did not penetrate his body, forcing the assailants to use logs to kill him.

Confirming the development on Thursday, the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), DSP Bright Edafe, said there was no open fight between the two cult groups, adding the attackers only monitored

their victims on the streets.

"What they do is that they monitor their targets on the streets. There hasn't been any open attack, and this makes it even more difficult to get these bad elements."

He said the police were on top of the situation, adding that all black spots in the community would not be spared in the cause of investigation.
