One killed as hoodlums clash in Osun

ONE person has reportedly been killed in Ede, Osun State following a clash that ensued between hoodlums living in the area on Wednesday evening.

Trouble had been brewing between the two groups in the past few weeks, after thugs invaded the abode of some residents, demanding for 'kola.'

It was gathered that the residents refused to settle the thugs on the argument that, a

group had once been collecting such money from them and wondered why another fee would be paid to another set of people, and this led to a clash.

Reacting to the development, the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Mrs Yemisi Opalola, confirmed the death, just as she said normalcy had been restored to the area.

Opalola said the police would not tolerate untoward acts in the society.
