Gunmen Attack Police Station, Kill Three Officers In Kogi

Some unknown gunmen numbering about six in their number on Saturday morning attacked the Ogaminana Police Station in Adavi local government council area of Kogi State killing three police officers on duty.

The attack was said to have been carried out around 2 am on Saturday.

According to the source, the gunmen were said to have attacked the police station from different directions as this development has caused panic around the town.

Confirming the incident, the State Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), SP William Aya in a statement said, "on Saturday the Command received a report of the unfortunate incident at Adavi Police Division where some hoodlums attacked the station from the opposite direction shooting sporadically but were repelled by the men on duty and operatives of the Quick Response Uni' Hi! How can we help you?

"However, the Command lost three of its officers during the gun duel, while the hoodlums fled \(\circ\) gunshot wounds as they could not get access to the station.

"The Commissioner of Police use this medium to call on the people of Adavi and the adjoining communities to be on the lookout and report anybody seen with bullet wounds to the Police or any other Security Forces nearest to them.
