## Boko Haram terrorists kill over 60 farmers, several missing in Borno

OKO Haram terrorists have raided Rann town, head-quarters of Kala-Balge Local Govern-

ment Area of Borno State, and killed over 60 farmers.

An eyewitness said several bullet wounds were discovered on the bodies of the victims, just as he said several farmers are still missing.

The source said the de-

ceased were buried on Monday according to Islamic injunction.

"The Boko Haram terrorists on motorcycles, armed with guns and machetes, surrounded their farms and started killing them one by

one," a villager narrated.

"Over 50 people were buried in Rann on Monday. As of this morning, more dead bodies have been found; the death toll is over 60 now."

Boko Haram had in recent times killed farmers, with

43 farmers killed in Zabarmari village in Borno State in 2020.

As of the time of filing this report, security agencies and state government were yet to react on the development.
