Bandits kill Zamfara lecturer after receiving N5m ransom

SUSPECTED armed bandits have killed a lecturer with the Zamfara State Polytechnic Talata Mafara, Sanusi Halilu Kaura after receiving payment of five million naira as ransom.

Saturday Tribune gathered that late Sanusi Kaura until his death was the Students Affairs Officer of the

Abdu Gusau Polytechnic in Talata Mafara in the state.

Late Kaura was killed by his abductors after payment of five million naira ransom for his release, after he spent five weeks in the kidnappers den.

Close Source to the family confirmed to the **Saturday Tribune**, that five million Naira ransom was paid to the bandits on Tuesday in a bush near some villages

along Kaduna – Zaria road, in Kaduna state.

“After the Bandits received the ransom of five million naira, less than twenty four hours, as we are waiting for his release, they confirmed to the family that he died, an indication that he was killed long ago even when Negotiations for his release was going”.

The late students affairs officer was kidnapped

along with other victims on his way to Abuja for NYSC mobilization to students of the Abdu Gusau polytechnic Talata Mafara in the state.

He was kidnapped along the Kaduna-Abuja highway and was taken to an unknown destination.

Late Sanusi Halilu kaura is an indigene of Kaura Namoda Local government area of Zamfara State.
