

3 Bandits shoot community leader, kill son, abduct four women in Plateau

BANDITS terrorising Mangu
Local Government Area of
Plateau State have killed a
young man, identified as
Chamsan, shot his father,
who is a community leader
at Angwan Baraya village,
Jannaret Ward in Gindiri
District of the council area,
Baba Yarima Jabil, and ab-
ducted two women.

The bandits also kid-
napped two other women
at Washna village in Pan-

yam District, also in Mangu
council area.

Nigerian Tribune learnt
that the bandits attacked
the residence of the com-
munity leader in the early
hours of Sunday, shot him
and his son, who died on
the spot.

A source close to the
family said the community
leader, who survived des-
pite sustaining multiple
gunshot wounds, is now
receiving treatment at the
General Hospital in Mangu,

while the bandits whisked
away his wife and one other
woman.

The source said the ban-
dits were yet to contact the
family.

The source described
Baba Yarima as a respected
community leader who had
groomed his children to be
successful in life, among
whom are Professor Y.Y Jabil
of the University of Jos; Dr
I. Jabil, the Deputy Provost
of National Veterinary Re-
search Institute, Vom Plat-

eau State and Dr Angel Jabil
also of the University of Jos.

Also on Saturday, the
bandits attacked Washna
village, where they abduc-
ted two women, includ-
ing Malama Hanatu Audu
Washna, mother of Mr Dan-
ladi Audu Washna of the
National Assembly, Abuja.

When contacted, the
state Police Public Relations
Officer (PPRO), DSP Alfred
Alabo, said the information
on the incidents had not
reached the command.
