

Bandits shoot community leader, kill son, abduct four women in Plateau

BANDITS terrorising Mangu Nigerian Tribune learnt Local Government Area of Plateau State have killed a the residence of the comyoung man, identified as munity leader in the early Chamsan, shot his father, hours of Sunday, shot him who is a community leader and his son, who died on at Angwan Baraya village, Jannaret Ward in Gindiri District of the council area, Baba Yarima Jabil, and abducted two women.

A source close to the family said the community leader, who survived despite sustaining multiple gunshot wounds, is now receiving treatment at the General Hospital in Mangu,

while the bandits whisked away his wife and one other woman.

The source said the bandits were yet to contact the family.

The described source Baba Yarima as a respected community leader who had groomed his children to be successful in life, among whom are Professor Y.Y Jabil of the University of Jos; Dr I. Jabil, the Deputy Provost of National Veterinary Research Institute, Vom Plateau State and Dr Angel Jabil also of the University of Jos.

Also on Saturday, the ~ handits attacked Washnavillage, where they abduc- ~ ted two women, includ-___ ing Malama Hanatu Audu Washna, mother of Mr Danladi Audu Washna of the ---National Assembly, Abuja.

When contacted, the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), DSP Alfred Alabo, said the information on the incidents had not reached the command.
