

# ③ Police rescue four, kill three kidnappers in Adamawa

OPERATIVES of the Adamawa State police command have rescued four abducted persons and killed three of the suspected kidnappers at Damare Hills, an area that is part of Holma and Sorau in Song and Maiha local government areas of the state.

The command's spokesman, SP Yahaya Ngoroje, in a press statement, said the operatives also recovered two AK-47 rifles, one pump-action gun, mobile phones, chains, padlocks, charms, among others.

He said the operation, which was carried out by operatives attached to Sorau Division and hunters at Damare Hills, yielded positive result.

According to Ngoroje: "The success was as a result of the follow-up strategy designed by the command to checkmate cases bordering on kidnapping, armed robbery, cattle rustling, unlawful possession of firearms, among others."
