

16 injured in Lagos-Ibadan road accident

SIXTEEN persons were involved in a road accident on Friday on the Lagos-Ibadan Expressway.

Four of the injured victims were reportedly burnt beyond recognition in the accident that occurred at

Oniworo, after Foursquare along the expressway.

Saturday Tribune learnt that the lone accident involved a Mazda bus with registration APP934XH.

A statement by the Federal Road Safety Corps, Education Officer, Florence Okpe, said the suspected cause of the accident was

excessive speeding.

The bus was reported to have rammed into the median strip and went into flames.

16 passengers were injured in the accident and have been taken to a medical facility for attention.

Okpe said the Sector Commander of FRSC in the

state, Umar Ahmed, had reiterated the need for motorists to stick to speed limitation and obey all traffic regulations.

While condoling the families of the deceased, she prayed that God should strengthen them for the losses.
