

# Three die in Bauchi auto crash

THREE persons died in an auto crash that occurred on Saturday, August 6, at Kula village on the Bauchi-Kano highway.

It was gathered that the accident, which occurred at about 6:15p.m., was reported to the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) at 6:20p.m.

The accident involved a red commercial Volkswagen Golf 2 car and a silver Mercedes Benz C230.

According to the First Information Report (FIR) from the FRSC, signed by K.M. Chadi, the probable cause of

accident was road traffic violation (RTV) and speed limit violation (SPV).

The number of people involved in the accident is 11, made up of six male adults, one male child and four female adults, out of which eight persons were injured, comprising five male adults and three female adults.

The three who were killed are one male adult, one male child and one female adult.

It was further gathered that the injured were taken to the General Hospital in Kafin Madaki by police and FRSC personnel in Kafin Madaki.
