One dead, two injured in Ibadan multi-vehicle accident

ONE person was killed while two others sustained injuries in an accident involving seven vehicles at Ologuneru area of Ibadan on Tuesday.

The Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) sector commander in Oyo State, Mr Joshua Adekanye, confirmed the accident to the *News Agency of Nigeria (NAN)* on Wednesday in Ibadan.

The FRSC boss said 10 people were involved in the accident.

He said vehicles involved were two trucks, two Toyota Camry cars, a KIA car and two

motorcycles.

He attributed the cause of the accident to speed violation and loss of control on the part of one of the trucks.

Adekanye said the police took the body of the dead to a mortuary, while the injured were taken to Ibadan Central Hospital by FRSC personnel.

The FRSC boss urged drivers, especially those of heavy duty vehicles to always drive with caution and ensure they service their vehicles regularly.
