The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), SP William Ayah, in a press statement on Wednesday,

confirmed the development.

Avah confirmed that the

<u>armed</u> robbers invaded <u>the three banks in Ankpa</u> community simultaneously.

He said: "The Commissioner of Police, Edward Egbuka, immediately led a team of tactical operatives to the scenes for on-the-

spot assessment.

"He has equally ordered the deployment of additional operational assets, comprising operatives of the Police Mobile Force, Counter Terrorism Unit, Quick Response Unit, State Intelligence Bureau (SIB), in synergy with other security agencies, to restore normalcy in the areas.

"The police personnel on duty, both at the station and the banks repelled the attackers, who were forced to flee from the areas."
